

# More on Hedge Laying



## :: *Agricultural Hedge*



Agricultural boundary hedge - grazing land

The hedge was evenly planted with a mixture of blackthorn and hawthorn. It was about 15 years old and was around 4m high.

The project was to lay in a 'Yorkshire style' - low and narrow - to create a thick and woody base (lamb-proof) and plenty of potential for re-rooting and re-growth.

The following work was undertaken

- Faced-up and cut into the hedge,
- Laid the sound growth, Yorkshire style.
- Supported with stakes about every 2 metres.
- Top line and stakes trimmed to give a finished height of about .75 m
