

# Case Studies



## :: *Boundary Hedge, Rural Garden/Agricultural Land*



A rural property in North Yorkshire - boundary along garden edge comprising over-mature and dense blackthorn. Overgrown (to 5m high) and too thick and unruly ..... no longer an effective hedge.

The customer wanted the hedge restored and rejuvenated by cutting out unwanted and poor main stems, followed by hard laying of the remaining material.

The following work was undertaken:

- Cut out and remove all unwanted material including some 'blackthorn trees'
- Lay hard and stake as required
- Plant gaps with hawthorn
- Final trim to acceptable height
- Final tidy
- Provide on-going consultancy for 12 months re. Management.
