

Case Studies



:: Highway Margin



Local highway margin – young (15 years approx) and well planted hawthorn in need of first laying.

The hedge was even planted (about 4 plants/m) and was around 6m high.



The project was to lay in a local traditional style and to leave waste material for subsequent disposal – this involved removing post and rail fencing.



The following work was undertaken

- ❑ Faced-up and cut into the hedge and removed unwanted weak plants/side growth.
- ❑ Layed the remaining sound growth, midlands style.
- ❑ From adjacent coppice cut hazel for binders, and sycamore for stakes.
- ❑ Staked at about 1m centres and bound with hazel cut on site.
